

## COOKIES

This website uses cookies within its Content Management System and these are outlined below. A cookie is a small data file that is stored by your Web browser on your computer. However, please note that our videos are embedded in YouTube which will set a cookie and sharing the site, for example via Twitter or Facebook, can produce numerous further cookies.

"ASP.NET\_SessionId".

For session control. This cookie is only used to establish connections between the client and the server, so no private data is held.

The cookie is removed as soon as you close your browser.

"Auth".

For log in session and authentication, used only for Administrator, Editor or Publisher users updating website content.

The cookie is removed as soon as you close your browser.

"Style". –

For remembering accessibility options (i.e. the Standard View and High Visibility links at the bottom of each page). The

cookie is removed after 24 hours.

"\_atuvc". - 1 cookie to update the "share count" on the Add This function (see the Bookmark and Share icon at the top of the website). This cookie is called The cookie is removed after 48 hours.

- Numerous third-party cookies potentially used if the user decides to share the website via the Bookmark and Share icon. For instance, users sharing the website to Twitter will then receive cookies from Twitter.
